



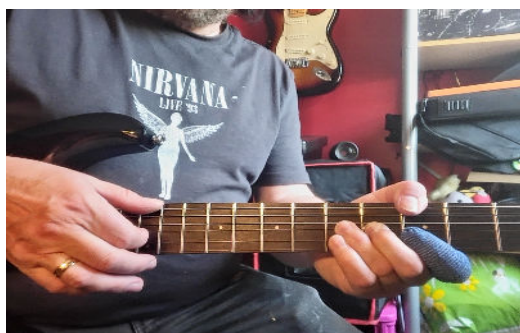
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Low Root Note On A Pentatonic In A minor - L16



WARNING - Finger picking required! Want to sound like a blues master - Billy Gibbons (ZZ Top). Easy trick is to add the low root on the bottom E string using the thumb over the top for each note. Use your index to pick the pentatonic scale notes and simultaneously pick the low E string at the root note using your thumb.

E|8-5-----| *Play these notes using your index finger on your strumming hand
B|----8-5-----| *
G|-----7-5-----| *
D|-----7-5-----| *
A|-----7-5-----| *
E|5-5-5-5-5-5-5-5-5-| Play these note with your thumb on your strumming hand.



Thumb on the fretting hand on the root (A on here)

On strumming hand use the thumb on the low E string and the index finger to play the actual scale.



You may want to try and hold your pick in your middle finger when playing this so it's easy to come back to when required.
